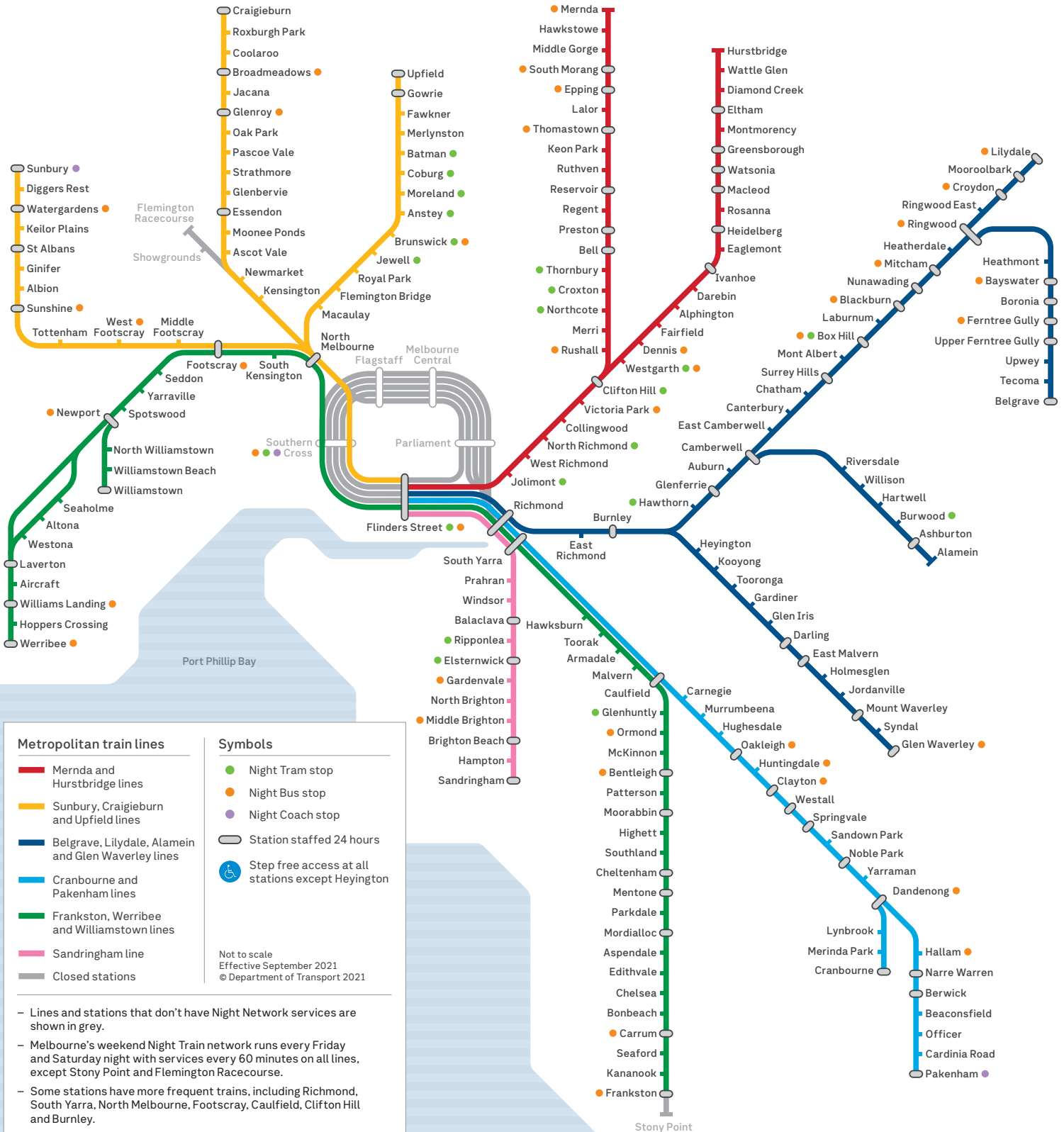


Melbourne weekend Night Train network

- Lines and stations that don't have Night Network services are shown in grey.
- Melbourne's weekend Night Train network runs every Friday and Saturday night with services every 60 minutes on all lines, except Stony Point and Flemington Racecourse.
- Some stations have more frequent trains, including Richmond, South Yarra, North Melbourne, Footscray, Caulfield, Clifton Hill and Burnley.
- After 1am, all trains run direct to and from Flinders Street Station.
- Parliament, Melbourne Central and Flagstaff stations close just after midnight.
- Southern Cross Station closes just after 1am.
- Shuttle trains run on the Williamstown Line between Newport and Williamstown, the Alamein Line between Camberwell and Alamein, the Cranbourne Line between Dandenong and Cranbourne, the Lilydale line between Ringwood and Lilydale and the Belgrave Line between Ringwood and Belgrave.
- All services pick up passengers in both directions.
