Sample bingo template – transport safety

<p>Always stand behind the line markings and/or raised tactile ground surface indicators when waiting for a tram.</p>	<p>Watch your step, and use the handrail.</p>	<p>Always wait until the tram has moved away from the stop so you are able to check for trams travelling in the other direction, before crossing the tracks.</p>	<p>Always walk on the station platform and only carry or push bicycles, rollerblades or skateboards.</p>
<p>Allow passengers to alight before boarding the bus.</p>	<p>When waiting for the train, always stand behind the yellow line on the platform.</p>	<p>If you are travelling with a pram or shopping trolley on a train, board at the front carriage so that you're clearly visible to the driver.</p>	<p>Remember to hold onto the handrails. The tram may move off without you realising it, so this will help you keep your balance.</p>
<p>Always use the designated pedestrian crossings to cross train tracks.</p>	<p>Once the train doors have begun to close, remain behind the yellow line and wait for the next service.</p>	<p>Please wait for passengers to get off the tram before you board at any tram stop.</p>	<p>Remain seated throughout the bus journey.</p>
<p>Always wait for the bus to stop before speaking to the driver.</p>	<p>Check for traffic and bikes before stepping off the tram onto a shared road space.</p>	<p>Use the luggage racks to stow bags where possible. This will keep seats free for other passengers.</p>	<p>Take care when using escalators to ensure clothing and bag straps do not get caught.</p>
<p>Priority seats are provided on all trams for passengers with a special need for a seat, including pregnant women, seniors and passengers with a vision or mobility impairment.</p>	<p>Stay in your seat until the bus has come to a complete stop.</p>	<p>Wait until the train has stopped at a station before moving between carriages.</p>	<p>Always hold on as the tram may have to brake suddenly.</p>
<p>Watch your step, and use the handrail.</p>	<p>On the train, make sure your luggage is stowed correctly to keep the aisle clear.</p>	<p>Place schoolbags, shopping bags or briefcases on the floor between your feet.</p>	<p>Wait at the stop well clear of the bus until it has driven away before crossing the road.</p>
