**Bikes and pets**   

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

### Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

## Your replacement bus and tram stops

To familiarise yourself with your bus and tram stops ahead of time, visit [ptv.vic.gov.au/upfield](http://ptv.vic.gov.au/upfield)

While buses and trams are replacing trains, keep a look out for wayfinding and directional signage. If you're having trouble finding the bus or tram stops and would like to speak with someone, call **1800 800 007**.

## Brunswick bus interchange

While buses replace trains, replacement buses for passengers between Batman and Upfield will operate to and from Brunswick Station.

If you're travelling home from the City, remember to catch an Upfield Line train to Brunswick to connect with your replacement bus service towards Upfield.

 The Route 19 tram on Sydney Road connects with Brunswick, Anstey, Moreland, Coburg and Batman stations.



## Car and bicycle parking

Additional car parking has been provided at Batman Station. Car parking is not available at other stations along the Upfield Line towards the City.

For those looking to ride their bicycles, additional bicycle parking is available at Brunswick Station.

## Road disruptions

There will be road closures and traffic impacts in Coburg and Brunswick around the level crossing sites.

## Station closures

Moreland and Coburg stations are closed and the new stations will open in mid-December.

Once the Upfield Line reopens on **Monday 16 November**, Moreland and Coburg stations will remain closed and trains will run express through the stations.

A shuttle bus service will operate between Anstey and Batman stations from **Monday 16 November** to **mid-December** to connect you to train services.

# We're busy removing level crossings

As part of Victoria's Big Build, we're removing four dangerous and congested level crossings on the Upfield Line.

Buses and trams replace trains on sections of the Upfield Line until the last service **Sunday 15 November**. While you're on the bus or tram, we'll be removing the crossings at Munro and Reynard streets, Moreland Road and the notorious Bell Street level crossing.

Coburg and Moreland stations will be closed until mid-December while we build two brand new stations.

## Information for passengers between Batman and Upfield

Your replacement transport services have changed, and will now take you to Brunswick Station on the Upfield Line.

If you're travelling from the City, remember to catch an Upfield Line train to connect with your replacement bus service towards Upfield.




