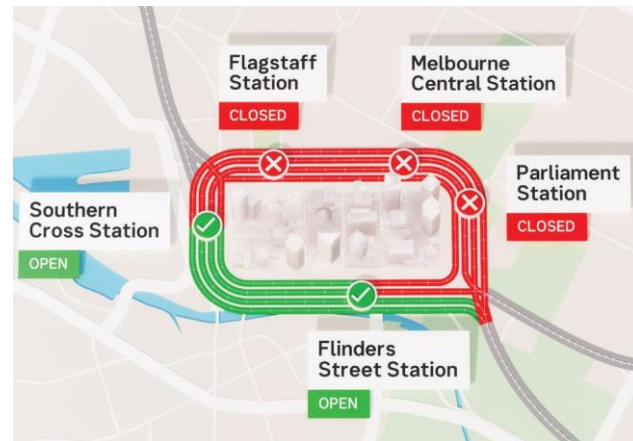
City Loop closed

Flagstaff, Melbourne Central and Parliament stations will be closed.

There will be no City Loop services and trains will run direct to Flinders Street or Southern Cross stations.

Take a Werribee, Williamstown, Sunbury or Craigieburn line train to travel between Flinders Street and Southern Cross stations.



Travelling to events in the city

Replacement buses are planned to ensure you can travel to and from the city.

For passengers attending the Australian Open, buses arrive and depart from Federation Square which is a short walk to Birrarung Marr and the City Entrance of the Australian Open.

Route 70 or Route 70a trams from Flinders Street to Stop 7B Rod Laver Arena/MCG gates 1-3 will also take passengers to the Garden Square Entrance of the Australian Open.

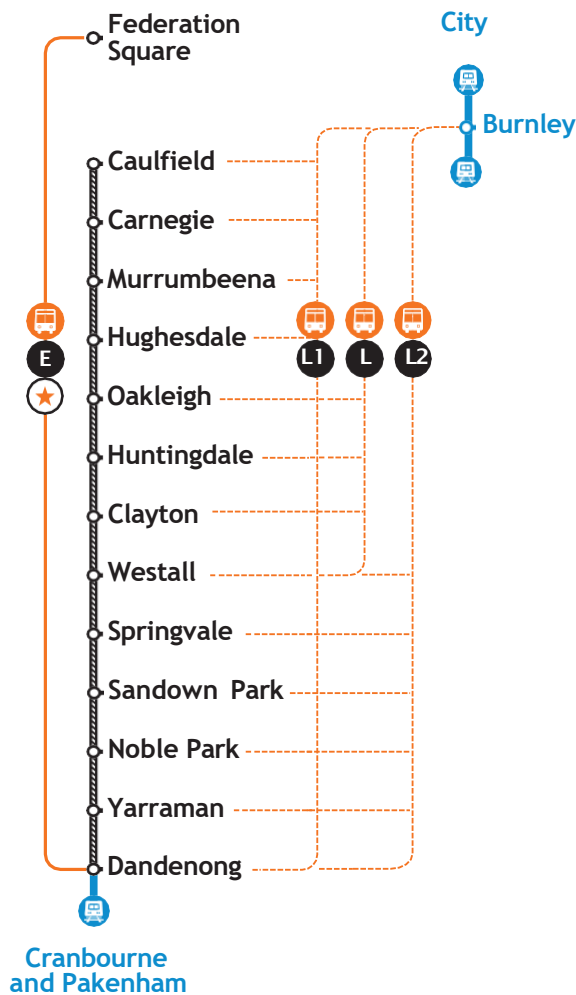


Buses replace trains

Express buses will extend to stop all stations to between Dandenong to Pakenham and Cranbourne from 8.30pm to last service on 8th and 12th January

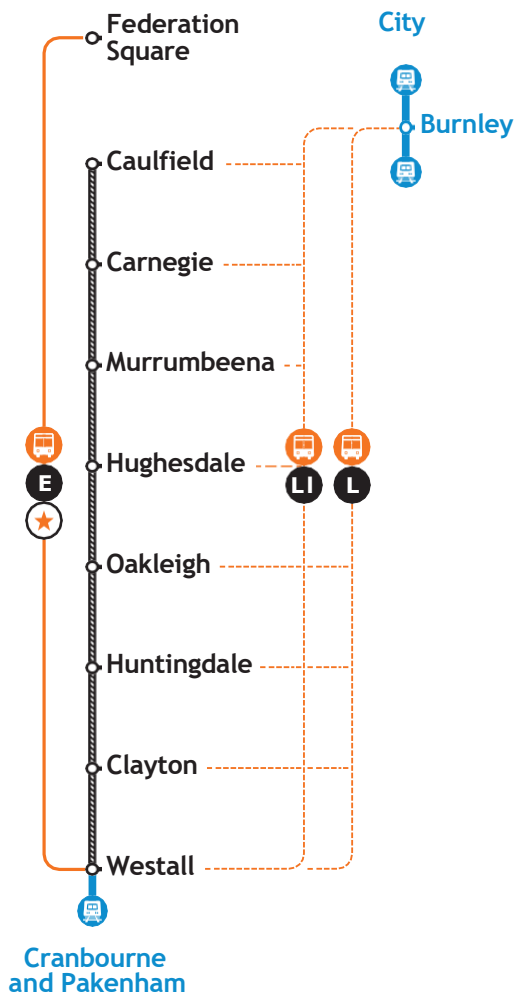

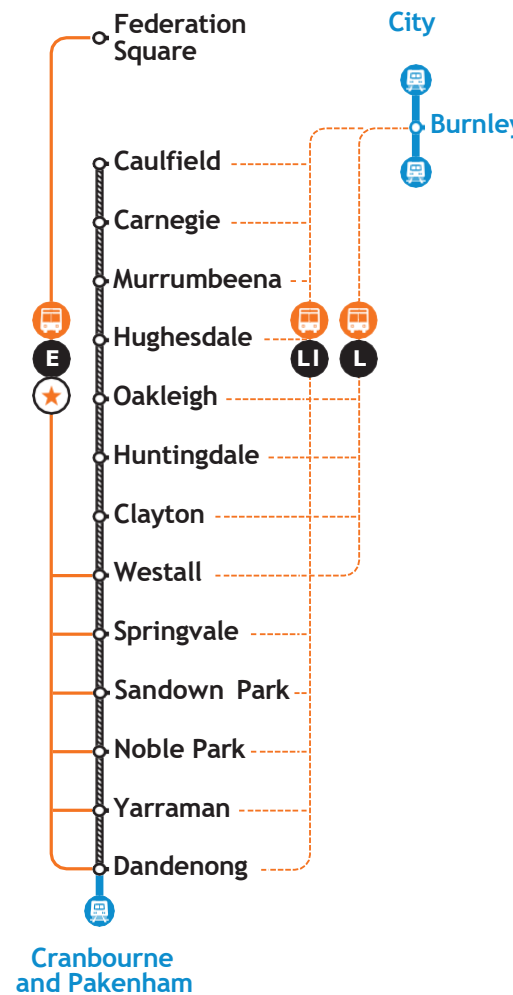
