

Buses replace trains on the Belgrave and Lilydale lines

Tuesday 30 January
to April 2024



Level crossing removal works continue in Ringwood, Croydon and Lilydale

We're removing three dangerous and congested level crossings at Bedford Road in Ringwood East, Coolstore Road in Croydon and Cave Hill in Lilydale.

We're working around the clock to build a new rail trench at Bedford Road and Dublin Road. We're also building a new Ringwood East Station.

At Coolstore Road a brand new Croydon Transport Hub is being built featuring a new station, upgraded bus interchange and improved local roads.

While we work, buses will replace trains on sections of the Belgrave and Lilydale lines from **Tuesday 30 January to April 2024**.

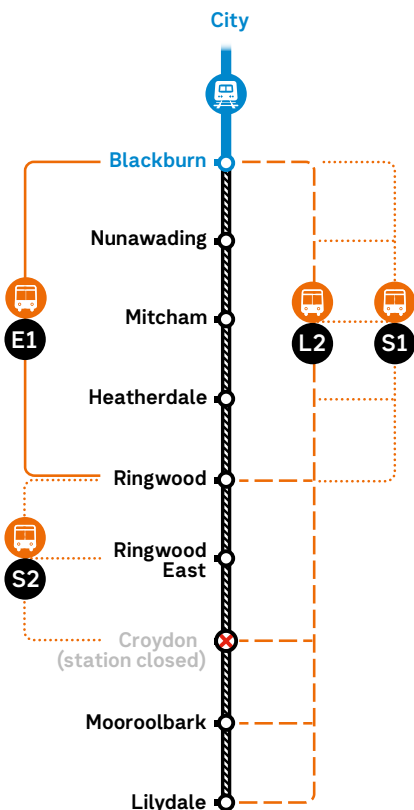

Croydon Station temporarily closed

Croydon Station will temporarily close from **8.30pm Tuesday 30 January**.

All facilities, including myki services and the Parkiteer will be unavailable. Alternative bike hoops will be available near the park at 99 Main Street, Croydon.

The new Croydon Station will open by **Spring 2024**.

Croydon Station shuttle bus service

While the station is closed, trains will not stop at Croydon Station.

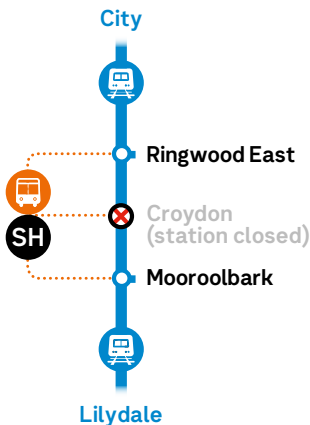
A shuttle bus service will connect passengers from Croydon to trains at Ringwood East and Mooroolbark stations.

Travelling on a replacement bus

Accessibility

Most train replacement buses will be low-floor models to assist passengers.

If you need help or cannot board a replacement bus, please contact PTV, prior to travelling, on **1800 800 007** or speak to our staff at the bus stop for alternative transport to be arranged at no cost.

Bikes and pets

Bicycles, dogs (with the exception of animals identified by an Assistance Animal Pass) and surfboards are not allowed on train replacement buses.

Ticketing

Where possible, you should touch on and off at the beginning and end of your journey. When catching train replacement buses, you can touch on and off at your connecting train station.

To avoid delays, top up your myki online at ptv.vic.gov.au, instantly via the **PTV app** or set auto top up.
