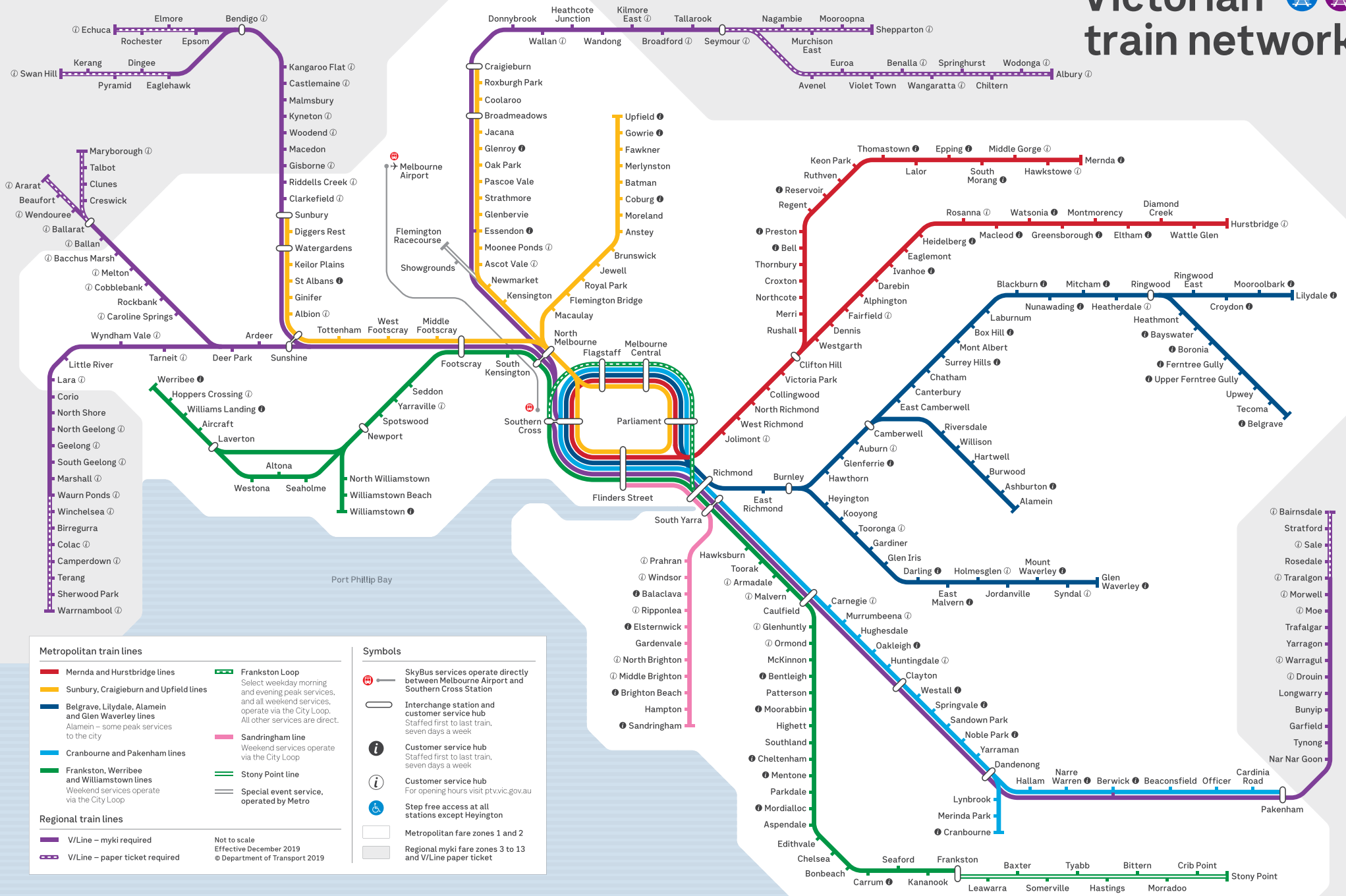


Victorian train network



Metropolitan train lines

- Mernda and Hurstbridge lines
- Sunbury, Craigieburn and Upfield lines
- Belgrave, Lilydale, Alamein and Glen Waverley lines
Alamein – some peak services to the city
- Cranbourne and Pakenham lines
- Frankston, Werribee and Williamstown lines
Weekend services operate via the City Loop
- Sandringham line
