

Student Quick Play Guide

**LOOK
BOTH
WAYS**

▶ Follow the easy steps in this guide to help you play the game and make sure you have the Look Both Ways world imported in Minecraft Education.

Step 1

Talk to Dot to get information about the different areas of the 'Lobby.'

Step 5

Change the behaviour of the pedestrians behaving unsafely by throwing the correct bean bag at them.

Step 2

Practice hitting 10 targets with the correct colour bean bag.

Step 6

Once everyone in the group has finished crossing, wait for the trams to leave and speak to Dot.

Step 3

Check the Group Information Wall to see what behaviours and locations to focus on in the upcoming group.

Step 7

Repeat steps 3 to 6 until you run out of Unsafe Coins.

Step 4

Call the next group of pedestrians by right clicking the 'Call Group' button on the Group Information Wall.

Step 8

Have another go to try and improve the number of Gold Coins you collected.

Handy hints

▶ **Group Information wall**
Check the Information Wall before every group, so you know what behaviours you need to change.

▶ **Coins**
If you run out of green coins, that is OK, try again and get yourself a better trophy.

▶ **On a tablet or phone with touch controls?**
We highly recommend "Joystick & aim crosshair." You can change this in Settings -> Touch.

▶ **Be Patient**
As stressful as it feels, you do have time to change the behaviour, you don't need to rush your beanbag throws.

▶ **After wave 7**
After the 7th wave is passed, use your coins wisely to purchase safety campaigns. Check which behaviours are coming up and change or turn off campaigns if they don't match.

Talk to your friends and class mates about how to stay safe around trams and tram crossings.
